Tournament Rules and Conditions

This tournament is open to all TBA Registered Youth & Junior bowlers and is a scratch event. A Youth is defined as a bowler who has not reached the age of 21 years on January 1st of the current year, and Junior is defined as a bowler who has not reached the age of 18 on January 1st of the current year.

This Tournament is a combined Division Event

All Female bowlers entering will receive 8 bonus pins per game

This event will be a TBA ranked tournament for Youth/Junior bowlers.

All games will be bowled in accordance with the TBA rules and regulations.

TBA registered player cards must be presented at check-in.

No bowler is permitted to have more than one entry in this event.

Bowlers must wear neat and acceptable attire. Trousers, skirts or shorts must be tailored.

The tournament Director reserves the right to check any bowler's equipment at any time. Any equipment found to breach TBA regulations will result in disqualification with no claim on any prize money.

Bowlers are not permitted to smoke while actually competing in this tournament.

Any bowlers not checked in by the advertised time will be disqualified and will have no claim on any prize money nor have any deposit on entry refunded

Any matters not covered in these conditions will be decided by the Tournament Director whose decision will be final.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT

Qualifying squads on Saturday: 9:00 am for 9:30am start and 1.00pm for a 1:30 pm start

Lanes will be dressed prior to each squad

Sunday morning check in is at 9.00am for 9.15am start

Matchplay to start at 11.00am

ALL Pinfall is to be carried over in all stages

All female bowlers will receive 8 bonus pins per game in all games.

10 Games qualifying on Saturday moving after every game

Cut to top 12 who will bowl an additional 6 games sprint on Sunday

Should a tie occur for 12th place then a 10th frame playoff will decide 12th place

Cut to top 6 who will then bowl 5 game match play

Should a tie occur for 6th place then a 10th frame playoff will decide 6th place

20 pins for a win & 10 pins for a draw

Final placings will be decided by total pinfall at the completion of matchplay

Should a tie occur for 1st place then a 10th frame playoff will decide 1st place

If there is a tie for any minor positions then the prize fund will be shared for that position
